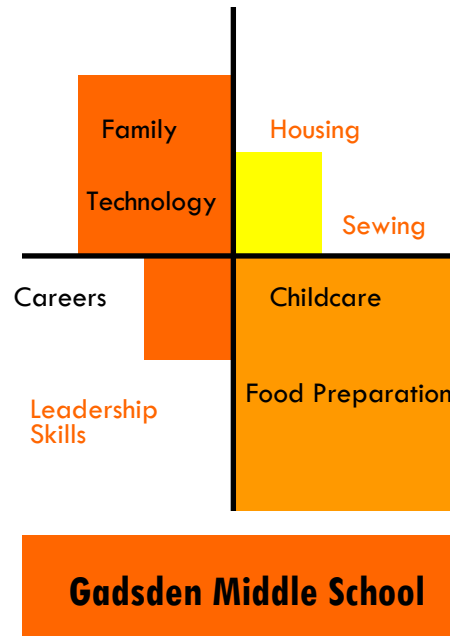


Family and Consumer Science (FACS) is an elective course offered to all students at Gadsden Middle School.
